Last month, we had the opportunity to be the location for Governor Tom Corbett's press announcement regarding his plan for privatizing the state liquor stores.

Although this was not an issue

the **Chamber's Legislative Team** had discussed in detail, we felt it would be a great opportunity to hear first hand details regarding the distribution of the revenue.

In our acceptance of Governor Corbett's visit, I requested he allow time to meet with our member beer distributors–Lil' Debi's High Street Brews and Village Beverage Mart, Inc., which he was quite willing to do. They met with him for approximately 15 minutes and discussed their concerns of his plan as it affects small distributors.

During the course of the announcement and subsequent media questions, Governor Corbett acknowledged his willingness to consider other options for a privatization

> plan. This is the first time he has publicly made that statement.

There are likely to be a number of amendments to House Bill 790 upon its release from committee, and, there is little doubt the Senate will offer a privatization bill as well. I encourage all of you to contact our local legislators and share your thoughts on this, or any other piece of legislation that affects your business. It's our duty as constituents to make sure our voices are heard.


At the **February membership breakfast**, the inaugural Green Business recognitions were handed out to each of the four plants of **Knouse Foods Cooperative**, **Inc.** -


### **Career Fair**






