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Local Businesses Invited to Participate in Gettysburg's 17th Taste of the Town

Gettysburg, Pa. – Businesses are invited to showcase their best food and beverage offerings to 400 foodies during the 17th Taste of the Town, hosted by the Gettysburg Adams Chamber of Commerce from 2-5 p.m. on Sunday, April 8, at Liberty Mountain Resort, Carroll Valley.

Registration for the sell-out event is open to 30 vendors, including restaurants, bakeries, caterers, wineries, retail stores and more. The deadline to register is March 9.

Chamber members can get booth space for \$55 while the cost for future members to participate is \$65. New this year, a limited number of spaces are available in "The Marketplace" for vendors who wish to sell products. Marketplace rates are \$75 for chamber members and \$85 for future members. Registration includes an eight-foot table to market food and beverage products to a targeted audience, pre- and post-event promotion and eligibility for the "2018 People's Choice" award.

Vendors are asked to bring 400 samples of one or two items that are featured on a current or upcoming menu. Vendors must provide all cooking and storage equipment, utensils, plates, napkins and glasses for sampling.

Food businesses must provide a copy of a current Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture food license, while vendors serving alcoholic beverages must follow all Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board laws.
