Accommodations with packages tailored to wine festival attendees start at \$139 per night and include tickets to the event, overnight accommodations and breakfast. Free shuttle service is provided from 1863 Inn of Gettysburg and Comfort Suites Gettysburg.

Save 20% by purchasing one-day tickets in advance at \$20. Tickets bought at the gate are \$25. Two-day advance tickets are available for wine enthusiasts at \$30. All tickets include a free wine glass, unlimited wine sampling and access to live music. Youth/Designated Driver tickets are \$12 and children 12 and under are free. Special pricing is available for groups of more than 15 people. Parking is free.
