10th Annual Gettysburg Wine & Music Festival Announces Diverse Lineup of Region's Top Musical Acts

Gettysburg, Pa. – The 10th Annual Gettysburg Wine & Music Festival, central Pennsylvania's premier wine event, will spotlight some of the region's best live musical acts Sept. 6-7 from noon to 6 p.m. at the Gateway Gettysburg Complex.

Hosted by the Gettysburg Adams Chamber of Commerce, the festival also features 25 wineries sampling hundreds of Pennsylvania wines and more than 50 food and craft vendors.

The lineup on Saturday, Sept. 6:

- **12:30-2 p.m. – Half Serious**, one of the region's most sought after cover bands rocking hits from the 70's to today. They have three lead singers, three guitars and a thumping rhythm section that helps them deliver legendary covers.
- **2:30-4 p.m. – The Reagan Years**, a band of seasoned musicians who recreate the sounds of the 1980s; a day when Ronald Reagan was President, MTV first aired, CDs emerged, acid washed jeans were "cool" and alternative music was called "New Wave." Their show is a party that'll bring back memories from one of music's best decades.
- **4:30-6 p.m. – Brittany Opperman**, a talented young country artist from Gettysburg, writes and sings songs about the twists and turns of life. Every person has a story and she tells her own through music and lyrics that stir the soul.

The lineup on Sunday, Sept. 7:

- **12:30-2 p.m. – Michael Christopher**, whose music gets you tapping your toes and singing the tunes in your head for days to come. Michael paints a picture with lyrics and music. He's fresh on the scene and brings a distinctive edge of showmanship and swagger to the country genre.
- **2:30-4 p.m. – Bluesman Tom Larsen Dynamic Duo**, one of the most dynamic and original performers on the blues scene. The Dynamic Duo doesn't rely on drum machines, computers or tricks; they're just two passionate musicians playing real, live music, throwing down and jamming out.
- **4:30-6 p.m. – The Muddy Crows**, a Modern Americana/Folk-Rock band from Washington, D.C., that features original material from singer/songwriter Dan Wolff that combines Americana with folk, jazz, island rock and a bit of old-school soul. Their music captures the struggles, triumphs and humor of daily life.

D.J. Matt Claeys will provide music between performances.

One-day advance tickets are \$20 and include a free wine glass, unlimited wine sampling and access to live music. Tickets are \$25 at the gate. Two-day advance tickets are available for wine enthusiasts at \$30. Designated driver tickets are \$12 and children 12 and under are free. Special pricing is available for groups more than 15 people. Parking is free.

Hotel packages are available from the 1863 Inn of Gettysburg, Comfort Suites, Courtyard by Marriott Gettysburg and Wyndham Gettysburg and include free shuttle transportation to the festival.
